GUIDELINES FOR STORING AND INSTALLING BOARDS

Storage

It is important to store the skirtings in their original packaging in a room with a relative humidity of 45-65% and a temperature of 18-22°C, avoiding direct contact with the floor by placing them on an insulating layer such as a pallet, Styrofoam or cardboard.

Assembly

Before installation, the skirtings should be acclimatized in the room where they will be installed for at least 24 hours. In the room, it is important to measure the wall humidity and paint adhesion test, and the skirtings should be checked for possible defects and damage. Installation should be done using an appropriate base glue, eg. Mamut Clue by Den Braven, and a thermo-melt glue that attaches the skirtings to the wall until the base glue is fully set. Installation of the skirtings should include connecting them tightly together, and additional security measures, such as sealing the joints and the upper edge of the moulding, are equally important.

It is not recommended to use sealing compounds at the joint between the skirting and the floor made in the floating system.

The installer is responsible for any defects occurring during installation. Do not install skirtings with damage as this may void the warranty and the responsibility for the situation is transferred to the installer or buyer.

Maintenance

Maintenance of skirting boards should be regular, regula including sealing cracks and gaps with acrylic. Before installation in specific rooms, such as a bathroom or kitchen, it is necessary to check the humidity and temperature conditions.

In humid rooms. It is recommended to use skirtings with increased moisture resistance with an HDF core, but their use in places at risk of flooding with water is excluded.

Exploitation

During operation. MDF/HDF skirting boards require that the air temperature and humidity be maintained at 18-22 °C and 40-60%, respectively. When washing the floor, avoid water getting under the skirting and clean with a damp cloth.

Underfloor heating may affect the skirtings, so you should monitor their condition and if necessary, fill the gaps with acrylic. Changing the color of the moulding coating during use is a natural phenomenon. especially under the influence of sunlight.

However, remember to use it tresponsibly, bearing in mind that MDF skirtings are sensitive to moisture and require appropriate climatic conditions. The manufacturer is not liable for defects resulting from incorrect installation or operation in accordance with specified conditions.




The manufacturer is not liable for defects resulting from improper installation or operation of the product, in particular for:

- · defects resulting from failure to maintain appropriate climatic conditions throughout the life of the product.


